## Remuneration Policy for Research Publications in Journals (Revision 2025)



# Directorate of Research Office of Research, Innovation and Commercialization (ORIC)

#### 1) Objective & Motivation

To strengthen its research culture, the University of Central Punjab (UCP) places strong emphasis on publishing high-quality research in reputable impact factor journals, focusing on creative work, groundbreaking discoveries, knowledge advancement, comprehensive reviews, and innovative solutions to local industrial, market, and societal challenges. It is widely recognized that UCP's internal research productivity can gain visibility and recognition at the national and international levels only when its research contributions are published in high-impact journals. To encourage this, UCP offers a structured remuneration policy for faculty members upon the publication of their research in such journals. The reward structure is aligned with the journal's ranking within its discipline, based on the latest HEC Journal Recognition Policy w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2024. The research publication remuneration policy mechanism is outlined below.

#### 2) Background

The University of Central Punjab (UCP) is dedicated to fostering impactful and original research that addresses local industrial, societal, and community challenges. To ensure such scholarly contributions are widely recognized and make a meaningful impact, UCP encourages faculty to publish in reputable, peer-reviewed journals that are indexed in international databases and possess a non-zero impact factor. Publishing in these high-quality journals not only enhances the visibility of UCP's research but also elevates the university's academic standing on both national and global platforms. As an incentive for such contributions, UCP provides financial rewards for publications in impact factor and non-impact factor journals. These rewards are determined in accordance with the journal's ranking, as outlined by the Higher Education Commission (HEC) Journal Recognition Policy.

The quality, originality, and impact of academic research can only be guaranteed when it is published in reputable journals that are well-recognized in their fields. While the rise in publishing platforms has created more opportunities for researchers, it has also led to a significant increase in low-quality and predatory journals. These journals often lack proper peer-review processes and are run by commercial publishers that focus more on profit than academic value through a "pay-to-publish" model.

This trend is especially risky for early-career researchers and junior faculty, who may be drawn to these journals because of faster publication times and fewer requirements. However, publishing in such journals can lower the quality of their research and hinder the development of creative and critical thinking.

To uphold strong academic standards, it's essential to assess journals using strict and clear criteria. Although the Impact Factor from Clarivate Analytics is widely accepted as a measure of journal quality, many in the academic community believe that journal evaluation should also consider subject-specific rankings and other indicators. This ensures that research is published in journals that reflect true academic excellence and relevance.

#### 2.1 New HEC Journal Recognition Policy – To Give Guidance

Recently, the Higher Education Commission (HEC) introduced a revised HEC Journal Recognition Policy to evaluate and rank academic journals based on their relevance and quality within specific subject areas. This policy considers journals that are indexed in internationally recognized databases such as the **Web of Science** (WoS) and **Scopus**.

As per the updated HEC Journal Recognition Policy, journals are classified into three categories based on their impact and academic credibility as mentioned in below Table-1

W Category – **Highest-ranked** journals.

**X** Category – **Intermediate-level** journals.

**Y** Category – **Lower tier** but recognized journals.

This categorization system is designed to encourage researchers to publish in reputable, highimpact journals, thereby promoting quality research output within the academic community.

#### 2.2 Rationale for Remuneration Policy for Research Publications

The revised HEC Journal Recognition Policy has been developed with the vision of establishing a "recognition and reward ecosystem" where high-quality research output is promoted and incentivized. This aligns closely with the objectives of the University of Central Punjab (UCP), which emphasizes the importance of publishing in reputable, high-impact journals. Accordingly, UCP's new research publication policy adopts the framework of the HEC Journal Recognition Policy and will provide financial incentives based on the journal's category — W, X, or Y — as defined in this policy, provided that the research is published in a HEC recognized journals. The rationale for adopting this national-level framework includes the following key points:

#### 1. Standardized Journal Ranking Framework:

The HEC Journal Recognition Policy is easily accessible that serves as an efficient tool for verifying the validity, recognition status, and ranking of journals across various disciplines.

#### 2. Structured Categorization of Academic Journals:

The policy introduces a standardized classification rubric that categorizes journals into W (highest rank), X (mid-level), Y (lower rank based on their relevance and performance in specific subject areas. This allows for greater transparency and consistency in evaluating publication quality.

#### 3. HEC-Aligned Journal Ranking Criteria:

One of the key eligibility conditions for receiving the HEC Best Publication Award is that the research paper must be published in a W category journal, as defined by the HEC Journal Recognition Policy. By aligning with this criterion, UCP ensures its faculty remain eligible for such prestigious national honors.

#### 4. Support for Academic Evaluation:

The HEC classification system facilitates more efficient and standardized evaluation of research contributions for faculty promotions and Ph.D. degree awards, by providing a reliable benchmark for assessing publication quality.



#### 5. Categorical Journal Segmentation for Research Assessment:

The adoption of a uniform national framework helps reduce subjective disputes and grievances related to varying impact factors across disciplines, thereby fostering fairness in research assessment.

#### 3) Working Model of Remuneration Package for Research Publications

Upon confirmation that a journal is listed in the Journal Citation Report (JCR) with a non-zero impact factor, the total remuneration is calculated using the formula outlined in Equation (1). The minimum amount to be awarded starts from Rs. **35,000/-** and can go up to maximum Rs. **75,000/,** depending on the journal's category (W, X, or Y) as defined by the HEC Journal Policy.

While journals with an **impact factor** receive remuneration according to their category and ranking within their subject area, **non-impact factor journals** that are recognized by HEC and fall under W, X, or Y categories are also eligible for publication incentives.

Here;

I.F represents Impact Factor of the Journal calculated through WoS-JCR.

Category is the amount as mentioned in below Table-2.

#### 3.1 Eligibility Conditions & Filing of Remuneration Case

Following eligibility conditions are essential for the filing of remuneration case to the Directorate of Research on account of impact factor publication:

- 1) An applicant should be a full-time faculty member or research/working staff of UCP.
- 2) In a research publication, the UCP member should mention his/her sole institutional affiliation with UCP via the name "University of Central Punjab (UCP), Lahore, Pakistan". The UCP member can further associate his/her faculty/department with the institution name, if required. However, Foreign affiliation as second affiliation shall also be considered.
- 3) The corresponding author shall be considered the principal author, irrespective of their position in the author list.
- 4) In cases where the corresponding author is not listed as the first author, they shall be considered as occupying the first position for the purpose of remuneration calculation. Consequently, the author originally listed at the first position shall not be eligible for remuneration in such instances.
- 5) For remuneration purposes, the journal impact factor shall be capped at 12.5. Any journal with an impact factor exceeding this limit will be considered as having an impact factor of 12.5 or maximum remuneration which is Rs. 75,000/- under this policy.
- 6) If a publication includes more than six (6) authors, the total remuneration amount (prior to author position considerations) shall be divided by two (2).
- 7) Review papers are considered while conference papers are not considered for remuneration.
- 8) Only publications appearing in journals recognized by the HEC as W, X or Y with volume, and page numbers shall be considered for paper remuneration.

- 9) The remuneration amount should be claimed in the same calendar year in which the article is published. If a paper is published in December, it shall be eligible for submission to the ORIC until 10th February of the subsequent year
- 10) The allocation of remuneration amount is based on the number of author(s) and position of author(s) as illustrated below in tables. Here, Table-3 is applicable for local collaboration. In case, if there is foreign author (outside Pakistan) in top-3 authors i.e., international collaboration, Table-4 will be applied.




