TAAKRA will return with more opportunities for participants to challenge themselves, connect with others, and explore new possibilities.
















Workshop and Seminars

Takhleeq Business Incubator's Female Entrepreneurship Support Program



At Takhleeq Business Incubator, Maaike Doyer, Founder and Managing Partner at Epic Angels, shared insights to support female entrepreneurship at UCP. Epic Angels, the largest global female-only angel network, focuses on empowering women-led startups. Maaike discussed key topics, including what investors look for—seeking resilience, passion, and problem-solving drive beyond just numbers—understanding the funding cycle from pre-seed to Series A and beyond, and the importance of solving real, impactful problems.

She also addressed the challenges female founders face, offering strategies to overcome funding biases and networking obstacles, and emphasized the power of mentorship from experienced investors and founders. The session featured an interactive segment with participants showcasing their products, followed by a Q&A, providing insights for female students aspiring to build their own businesses.

Introducing Lexiconc: A Corpus Tool for Lexical Bundles and Concordances



Faculty of Languages and Literature organized a research seminar on "Introducing Lexiconc: A corpus tool for lexical bundles and concordances". The invited speaker of the talk was Dr. Muhammad Afzaal, Associate Professor at Shanghai International Studies University, China. The audience was scholars of PhD linguistics, MPhil linguistics, and literature. Dr. Afzaal introduced Lexiconc and explained the corpustool for lexical bundles and concordances. He also discussed the importance of developing corpora of Pakistani languages and literary texts. 
UCP x Universitas Bengkulu MOU

Prof. Muhammad Akhyar Farrukh's Guest Lecture on Machine Learning in Nanocomposite Characterization at 4th ICCPS 2025



Muhammad Akhyar Farrukh delivered an insightful invited lecture on "The Role of Machine Learning in Advanced Characterization of Graphene-Metal Oxide Nanocomposites" at the 4th International Conference on Chemical and Pharmaceutical Sciences: Innovation to Commercialization (ICCPS 2025), held at Forman Christian College (A Chartered University), Lahore, from January 22-24, 2025.

Prof. Farrukh's lecture highlighted the transformative impact of machine learning (ML) in analyzing and optimizing graphene-metal oxide nanocomposites, crucial materials in catalysis, and environmental applications. He elaborated on how Al-driven techniques enhance precision, efficiency, and predictive capabilities in nanomaterials research, reinforcing the significance of machine learning integration in modern materials science.


UCP Students' Secured Runnersup Spot at 1st National Moot Court Competition


University of Central Punjab won 39th All Pakistan HEC Intervarsity Bodybuilding Championship

University of Central Punjab won All Pakistan Intervarsity Judo Men Championship 2024-25




UCP Student's Representation in ILT20 Championship 2025 Winning Team




